Sunday, 22nd April 2018

The students and teachers from partnership countries arrived. They were met at the bus station in Canicatti by their host families and teachers.



Monday, 23rd April 2018

The first school day started with the arrival at school both students and teachers. They were given accreditations and the programme. Then, the school community gathered at the main courtyard and the headmaster of the school, Michele di Pasquali welcomed the group. Next the school orchestra played countries anthems. All the partner countries had an opportunity to introduce themselves and exchange small gifts. Students, in groups, showed the school to their partners and the teachers, too.

After that, all the participants walked to the City Hall, where the formal reception was held. The reception was lead by the mayor of the city of Campobello di Licata. Then, the coordinators and the headmasters sat around a table facing the students and the teachers participants. The mayor gave a speech including topics such as the city, the project, the European Union values, the citizenship. Later the coordinators introduced their own countries, there was an exchange of presents and finally a photo of the group was taken.

After the visit to the city hall, the group went on Campobello tour guided by SG Bosco students and then they worked in international cooperative groups on the posters of Campobello landmarks.

In the afternoon session Talent Show and Erasmus Day presentations of each country were shown. The students were asked to fill in the grids on the content of the events being presented.

Students were collected by host families.



Tuesday, 24th April 2018

The project team worked on the activities for the Transnational Meeting in Alpiarca in Portugal. The working plan was set up for the teachers for the final steps of the project including the final report. . Then, the team worked on the platform (LMS) to share material, on the website and on eTwinning.

At the same time, the students went on their apprenticeship morning to the seven local companies to experience a working day of particular professions.

When their working day was over they started creating videos and posters on their experience.

After lunch the students and teachers attended a lecture on 'Our networked lives between opportunities and risks. Towards a conscious use of social networks.' By Prof. F. Pira

Professor at University of Messina. He focused on our lives online and their risks. After that, students went with their families again.



Wednesday, 25th April

Day off at school. Both students and teachers spent the day in Palermo, the capital of Sicily. We had a wonderful day visiting the landmarks of the city and learning about culture, art and history. Palatina Chapel, Royal Palace, the Parliament, the Cathedral and the streets where places we visited. Back to Campobello, everybody went back home.



Thursday, 26th April

The working day started with work group on video of the apprenticeship experience and posters about risks of online lives for their labour future.

Meanwhile the teachers worked on the final outcomes of the project. We set up the working lines for the next transnational meeting by mid June.

Later we were invited to see the students presentations on their experiences and the risk of on online lives.



Finally, each country was invited to take one of the posters of Campobello signed by all the students taking part in the short term mobility.

Next, we had lunch and set for Agrigento to visit the Valley of Temples, where we could admire Greek and Roman remains.

An European Voluntary Service member came to the school to talk about this program that enables young people to live some months in another countries working in a non- profit organizations. Teachers' and students' evaluation survey was conducted.

The teachers and the students completed their reports and all the activities planned for the meeting.

After lunch the certificates were handed out and some pictures were taken. The headmaster of Publiczne Gimnazjum nr 1 in Łódź and the main coordinator of the Erasmus project gave a farewell speech. Then, we had a farewell party. The party finished at 5.30 p.m.
